OCTOBER 13, 2004

To: Doleen Goodrow, a resident in the Town of Canton, Maine, County of Oxford,

Greetings:

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the voters of the said Town of Canton, qualified to vote in the Town affairs, to assemble at the Municipal Building in Canton Village in said Town on Wednesday, the 13th day of February 2004, AD at 6:15 p.m. in the morning, then and there to act on the following articles, to wit:

Kathleen Hutchins called Meeting to order at 6:15 p.m..

Article 1: To choose a moderator to preside at said meeting.

Don Hutchins nominated Diane Ray as moderator. Seconded by Jackie Conant. No other nominations, Diane Ray was elected and sworn in by the Town Clerk.

Article 2: Shall the Town of Canton vote to approve a Community Development Block Grant application for the Community Planning Grant Program in the amount of \$10,000 to devise a strategy and plan for relocation and recreation of the village outside the floodplain, and to submit same to the Department of Economic and Community Development and if said program is approved, to authorize the municipal officers to accept said grant funds, to make such assurance, assume such responsibilities, and exercise such authority as are necessary and reasonable to implement such program?

Motion by Craig Gammon to accept the article as read, seconded by James Dymant. So voted.

Motion by Don Hutchins to adjourn at 6:25 p.m. Seconded by Jackie Conant. So voted.
