

SPECIAL TOWN MEETING MINUTES
FEBRUARY 7, 2004

Oxford:

To: Doleen Goodrow, Constable in the Town of Canton, Maine, County of Oxford,

Greetings:

Article 3: Shall the Town of Canton vote to approve a Federal Emergency Management Agency Grant application for the following program and dollar amount:

and to submit same to the Maine Emergency Management Agency, as the agents for the Federal Emergency Management Agency, and if said program is approved, to authorize the municipal officers to accept said grant funds, to make such assurances, assume such responsibilities, and exercise such authority as are necessary and reasonable to implement such program?

Article 4: Shall the Town of Canton vote to accept the proposed revised Comprehensive Plan?
